

Centroid appoints Australian service partner

Sydney - American based Centroid Corporation of Howard, Pennsylvania, recently made their first Australian sale of the A532, a 5-axis CNC cylinder head porting machining centre, to local performance race shop Trick & Mansweto Racing, Prospect, NSW. The sale prompted a nationwide search for a partner capable of providing general CNC machine on-site set up and ongoing service and support for this and all anticipated upcoming sales of the turnkey package. The search resulted in the appointment of James Machinery from Western Sydney as Centroid's Australian service partner.
